## Nuclear Pharmacy Summer Internship Program

**Program overview:** The Nuclear Pharmacy Summer Internship Program is designed to provide an introduction to nuclear pharmacy for students with a strong interest in pursuing a career in the field. Internship hours meet the experiential requirements for the Authorized Nuclear Pharmacist designation and can be credited towards pharmacist licensure by the state board of pharmacy.

**Topics covered:** During this 10-week program, pharmacy students follow a structured process and work under the guidance of a pharmacy preceptor.

- Radiation safety
- Personnel monitoring
- Quality assurance
- Delivery procedures
- Routine pharmacist duties
- Internal audit
- Nuclear medicine department visit
