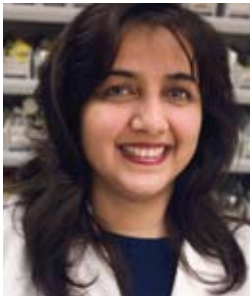

Nuclear pharmacy

Summer internships

Internship hours meet the experiential requirements for authorized nuclear pharmacist designation and can be credited towards pharmacist licensure by the state board of pharmacy.
